

NBIA

...stands for Neurodegeneration with Brain Iron Accumulation and is a group of **ultrarare hereditary neurological movement disorders** characterized by high levels of **iron in the basal ganglia** and a progressive degeneration of the nervous system.

Currently, there is **no cure or proven therapy** for any of the NBIA forms.




THE NBIA ALLIANCE

...is the first informal international umbrella association for NBIA lay advocacies, currently comprising 7 associations.

TIRCON IMPACT ON THE ALLIANCE

- Start of the NBIA Alliance as part of TIRCON dissemination at the TIRCON Kickoff meeting 2012
- Inspiration for patient representatives to launch new NBIA patient organizations in Spain, the Netherlands, Canada and UK
- Support of NBIA Alliance meeting and dissemination activities by TIRCON
- Networking NBIA Alliance partners and NBIA experts in TIRCON to enhance the advocacies' dissemination about NBIA research and medical care
- Telemedicine support of TIRCON clinicians to NBIA patients world-wide
- Providing an infrastructure for collaborative research and medical care with benefit for families and advocacies




CONCLUSIONS

The NBIA Alliance is...


- along with TIRCON an interconnector between lay advocacy and scientific networks worldwide

- a supporter of the development of Best Practices guidelines for all NBIA Disorders



Its main objectives are to **increase awareness** of NBIA in the health care community and the public, and to **support cooperative research** into NBIA Disorders.

TIRCON

...is an international consortium funded by the EU and investigating NBIA with a focus on PKAN. 13 partners from 8 countries are involved in TIRCON (Treat Iron-Related Childhood-Onset Neurodegeneration) including the lay advocacies NBIA Disorders Association (USA) and Hoffnungsbaum e.V. (Germany) as full partners and in charge for dissemination.





Due to their networking capacities, **NBIA lay** advocacies support **TIRCON** by...

- Contributing patients' needs and views
- Enhancing TIRCON's outreach as multiplicators of dissemination activities
- Supporting the **patient recruitment** for the NBIA registry, biobank and clinical study
- Enlarging the NBIA expert community by identifying new clinical/research centers
- Providing incentives for NBIA research projects and research-related events (e.g. travel grants to NA/NBIA Symposium 2014 for early-career scientists)
- Engaging in a **dialogue with stakeholders** to raise awareness on NBIA
- Endorsing promising collaborative research projects after TIRCON
